**Pet Partners® Program - Titters Policy**

---

Titers are accepted with recommendations by the handler's animal's veterinarian. It is important to note that titers do not protect one's animal from diseases but rather indicates a buildup of antibodies.

\*Rabies vaccinations, as required by law, are mandatory.

**\*Note:** Under certain circumstances, Delta will accept rabies titers as long as the health screening form is accompanied by a letter with the veterinarian's assessment and recommendations. See sample below:
